APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE EXCISE WAREHOUSE
(*Customs Act, Chap. 78:01*)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Excise (General Provisions) Act, Chap. 78:50, I, Fitzroy A. John, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place described in the Schedule hereunder to be a Private Excise Warehouse for the storage of spirits, manufactured in Trinidad and Tobago under the Excise laws, as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs. Trinidad Distillers Limited, Corner Eastern Main Road and Trinity Avenue, Laventille and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

SCHEDULE

A rectangular area measuring 19.1 m x 11.5 m comprising 219.65 square metres enclosed on the north, south, east and west by a concrete bund wall to a height of 1 metre, BRC wire mesh to a height of 8.5 metres, with two entrances also used as exits located on the southern and north-eastern side and covered by steel and galvanised sheets. The aforesaid area is to be called "Warehouse No. 14", containing five cylindrical stainless steel tanks as follows:

- Tank No. 27, with a working volume of 87,888 litres;
- Tank No. 28, with a working volume of 87,666 litres;
- Tank No. 29, with a working volume of 87,433 litres;

The aforesaid area is located in the north-western corner of the Trinidad Distillers Limited Distillery Complex, situate at Corner Eastern Main Road and Trinity Avenue, Laventille, bounded by a barrel shed on the north, a casking warehouse on the east, Private Excise Warehouse No. 6 [published as Notice No. 704 in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette* (Extraordinary) No. 96, dated April 3, 1986] on the south, and Private Excise Warehouse No. 5 [published as Notice No. 704 in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette* (Extraordinary) No. 94, dated April 3, 1986] on the west. THE CITIZEN SECURITY PROGRAMME (CSP) is an initiative of the Ministry of National Security that is partially financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) through a loan facility. The objective of the programme is to contribute to the reduction of crime and violence within 22 “high needs” communities throughout Trinidad and Tobago. The CSP will accomplish this through the financing of preventative interventions addressing the most proximal and modifiable risk factors.

The specific objectives of the Programme are (i) the reduction in the levels of homicides, robberies and woundings in partner communities; (ii) an increase in the perception of safety in the partner communities; (iii) a reduction of injuries related to firearms, child maltreatment, domestic violence and youth violence; and (iv) an increase in the collective efficacy to prevent violence in the partner communities.

To this end, the Programme’s activities have been organized into three (3) main components: (1) Community Action; (2) Assistance to the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS); and (3) Institutional Strengthening of the Ministry of National Security.

The Central Tenders Board on behalf of the Ministry of National Security now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the services of a consulting firm to provide the Citizen Security Programme, Ministry of National Security in the design and delivery of a training programme in Crime Prevention through Environmental Design. The duration of the assignment is seven (7) months.
