INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—December, 2012 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of December, 2012 was 203.3 representing a decrease of 1.6 points or 0.8% below the All Items Index for November, 2012.

The percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to December, 2012 over the period January to December, 2011 was 9.2%. This reflects an increase when compared with the rate of inflation of 5.1% observed in the average All Items Index for the period January to December, 2011 over the average All Items Index for January to December, 2010.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 510.2 in November, 2012 to 501.1 in December, 2012, reflecting a decrease of 1.8%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of cucumber, celery, tomatoes, oranges, green pigeon peas, yams, christophene, watercress, sweet pepper and chive/thyme. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of limes, ochroes, sweet potatoes, irish potatoes, hot peppers, king fish, canned vegetables, carite, mangoes and bodi.

Price changes in this section, for the month of December, 2012 accounted for a net overall decrease of 1.6 points in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for December, 2012 compared with November, 2012 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.1% and Health 0.4%. However a decrease was noted in the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear of 0.8%.

Price changes in the Other Sections, for the month of December, 2012 was negligible.
