INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—February, 2013 (Base: February, 2003 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of February, 2013 was 209.1 representing an increase of 0.6 points or 0.3% above the All Items Index for January, 2013.

The percentage change in the All Items Index for the period January to February, 2013 over the period January to February, 2012 was 6.5%. This reflects a decrease when compared with the rate of inflation of 8.0% observed in the All Items Index for the period January to February, 2012 over the period January to February, 2011.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 532.4 in January, 2013 to 536.4 in February, 2013, reflecting in an increase of 0.8%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of limes, ochroes, cucumbers, hot peppers, sweet potatoes, dasheen, green pigeon peas, sweet pepper, carite and watercress. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of christophene, tomatoes, celery, apples, carrots, carbonated soft drinks, buns and cakes, potato chips/corn curls/popcorn and onions.

Price changes in this section, for the month of February, 2013 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.7 points in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for February, 2013 compared with January, 2013 reflected decreases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.5% and Clothing and Footwear of 1.1%.

Price changes in the Other Sections, for the month of February, 2013 accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.1 points in the All
