IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for general information that His Excellency the Acting President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, in exercise of the power vested in him by subsection (1) of section 78 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and all other powers thereto him enabling, has revoked, with effect from the evening of 2nd March, 2014, the authority conferred on the Honourable Errol Mc Leod, M.P., by Instrument dated 21st February, 2014, to perform the functions of the Prime Minister.
