INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—May, 2014 (Base: January 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of May, 2014 was 220.3 representing an increase of 0.6 points or 0.3% above the All Items Index for April, 2014.

The percentage change in the All Items Index for the period January to May, 2014 over the period January to May, 2013 was 3.6%. This reflects a decrease when compared with the rate of inflation of 6.2% observed in the All Items Index for the period January to May, 2013 over the period January to May, 2012.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 573.4 in April, 2014 to 577.3 in May, 2013 reflecting an increase of 0.7%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of limes, sweet potatoes, oranges, mangoes, christophene, green pigeon peas, watercress, tomatoes, spices and avacado. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of ochroes, cucumbers, hot peppers, sweet potatoes, yams, pumpkin, whole chickens, dasheen, celery, chive/thyme and irish potatoes.

Price changes in this section for the month of May, 2014 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.7 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for May, 2014 compared with April, 2014 reflected decreases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Drinks and Tobacco of 0.4% and Clothing and Footwear 0.2%.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of December, 2013 were negligible.
