MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18(1) OF THE STANDARDS ACT

THE COMPULSORY STANDARDS (NO. 2) ORDER, 2016

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standards Citation (No. 2) Order, 2016.

2. On the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, the standards listed in the First Column of the Schedule with the corresponding titles in the Second Column of the Schedule, which were notified in Legal Notices No. 87 of 2016 and No. 107 of 2016, respectively, are hereby declared compulsory standards for the purposes set out in the Third Column of the Schedule.
