The National Awards of Trinidad and Tobago

In 1969 Cabinet was advised that Letters Patent were to be constituted establishing a society of honour in Trinidad and Tobago to be known as the Order of the Trinity, for the purpose of according recognition to citizens of Trinidad and Tobago and other persons for distinguished or meritorious service or for gallantry.

By and with the advice of the Cabinet a society of honour to be known as the "Order of the Trinity" was established and constituted.

And it was ordained, directed and appointed by and with the advice of the Cabinet the said Order would consist of the Queen (later President) of Trinidad and Tobago and such members together with honorary members as the President shall in accordance with the Constitution of the Order from time to time appoint. It was further ordained, directed and appointed that the Order shall be governed by the Constitution of the Order of the Trinity set out in the Schedule hereto.

The Order of the Trinity, consisted of the President of Trinidad and Tobago and the members and honorary members of the Order. Every citizen of Trinidad and Tobago to whom the Trinity Cross, the Chaconia Medal, the Humming Bird Medal or the Medal of Merit was awarded is a Member of the Order. Every person other than a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago to whom the Trinity Cross, the Chaconia Medal or the Humming Bird Medal was awarded on an honorary basis is an Honorary Member of the Order. The President of Trinidad and Tobago, by virtue of that Office, is the Chancellor of the Order.

THE TRINITY CROSS

The Trinity Cross of the Order of the Trinity was awarded to any person who rendered distinguished and outstanding service to Trinidad and Tobago. The Trinity Cross was also awarded posthumously, but a deceased recipient did not become a member of the Order. The Trinity Cross was awarded only in Gold to a maximum of ten persons in 1969 and five persons in any year thereafter until 2005.

THE ORDER OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

The Order of the Republic of Trinidad of Tobago replaced the Trinity Cross as the country's highest honour on June 5, 2008, and was first awarded in 2008. This award is granted to nationals and non-nationals for distinguished and outstanding service to Trinidad and Tobago. It is also awarded for gallantry in the face of the enemy, or for gallant conduct. It is only awarded in gold and is limited to five recipients each year, though the number may be less. The identifying colour on the border of ribbon for this medal is gold.

THE CHACONIA MEDAL

The Chaconia Medal may be awarded to any person who has performed long and meritorious service to Trinidad and Tobago tending to promote the national welfare or strengthen the community spirit. The Chaconia Medal may be awarded posthumously. The Chaconia Medal may be awarded in Gold, Silver or Bronze in accordance with the Committee's assessment of the value of the recipient's service to Trinidad and Tobago. The Chaconia Medal could have been awarded to a maximum of fifteen persons in 1969 but only ten persons in any year thereafter.

THE HUMMING BIRD MEDAL

The Humming Bird Medal may be awarded to any person who has rendered loyal and devoted service beneficial to Trinidad and Tobago in any field of human endeavour or for gallantry or other humane action. The Humming Bird Medal may be awarded posthumously. The Humming Bird Medal may be awarded in Gold, Silver or Bronze in accordance with the Committee's assessment of the level of the service rendered by the recipient. The Humming Bird Medal for loyal and devoted service could have been awarded to a maximum of twenty persons in 1969 but fifteen persons in any year thereafter.

MEDAL OF MERIT

The Public Service Medal may be awarded for outstanding and meritorious service in the Public

Services, the Defence and Protective Services or service with Statutory Bodies performing national functions. Only citizens of Trinidad and Tobago are eligible for the award of the Medal of Merit. The Medal of Merit may be awarded posthumously. The Medal of Merit may be awarded in Gold, Silver or Bronze according to the length or merit of the services rendered as assessed by the Committee.

There is a standing National Awards Committee comprising:

1. the Chief Justice of Trinidad and Tobago who shall be the Chairman of the Committee;
2. the Chairman of the Public Service Commission;
3. the Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission;
4. the Chairman of the Elections and Boundaries Commission;
5. a Senior Public Officer appointed by the Prime Minister;
6. two persons representative of the General Public appointed by the Prime Minister. Such appointment shall be for a period not exceeding three years but a person whose appointment so expires shall be eligible for re-appointment.

The Committee has a Secretary who is appointed by the Prime Minister. It considers nominations of persons of merit who are citizens of Trinidad and Tobago together with recommendations and supporting material received. Any person or organisation may submit to the Committee for its consideration a nomination of a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago for an award of the Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, the Chaconia Medal, the Humming Bird Medal or the Medal of Merit.

Statement From The Chairman of The National Awards Committee



THE HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE IVOR ARCHIE

I TAKE GREAT pleasure in saluting the 40th Anniversary of the Trinidad and Tobago National Awards Scheme. I do so in my capacity as Chairman of the Committee charged with administering these awards. I applaud the sterling contribution of my predecessors and also current and past members of this body in lending credence, integrity and trust to this annual national exercise.

It must be borne in mind that the Committee's deliberations begin with nominations from members of the public, and the final determination of the awards rests with the Executive. It means, therefore, that through this filtration process, persons who are recognized are subject to quite intense scrutiny by the national community, with paramount consideration for their selfless service in the interest of community and country.

Scores of our nationals would have been acknowledged publicly as exemplars via these national

awards, but there are hundreds of unsung citizens whose endeavours and devotion to their communities epitomize that spirit of doing for their country rather than waiting for their country to do for them.

Forty years of these awards, and 47 years of independence are short periods in the life of any country. But they are time enough for a nation to reap immense benefits in its political, social, economic and cultural development from the enterprise of members of its populace, individually and collectively, in the myriad spheres of national life that we recognize with these awards.

So has it been in the case of Trinidad and Tobago, and it is my fervent wish that these awards continue to inspire as we aspire and achieve together.

Preface

With the lowering of the Union Jack on August 1st 1962 and the raising of the Trinidad and Tobago National flag, Trinidad and Tobago became an independent nation.

Prior to this, Trinidad and Tobago, as a British colony, participated in the system of Commonwealth Awards conferred by Her Majesty the Queen of England. These Commonwealth Awards comprised the Peerage and Baronetage, Privy Councillors, various Orders of Knighthood, Decorations and Medals, in Civil and Military Divisions.

On gaining independence from Britain in 1962, it was decided that Trinidad and Tobago should have its own National Awards. This decision was effected on 21st December 1967 when Cabinet decided there should be seven (7) categories and fourteen (14) classes of National Awards. This was subsequently amended to four (4) categories and ten (10) classes of National Awards. In 1969, in commemoration of the Independence anniversary, National Awards were presented for the first time.

A National Awards Committee oversees the process for the nomination for National Awards annually. To ensure fair consideration is given to a wide cross-section of nominees, the National Awards Committee invites the public to submit the names of nominees annually. All citizens of Trinidad and Tobago of distinction, alive or deceased are eligible to be considered. The members of the National Awards Committee thoroughly investigate the nominees' activities in the field, after which, the Committee considers all the recommendations submitted. The Committee then forwards a shortened list to the Prime Minister for consideration.

According to the 1969 Constitution of the Order of the Trinity, the Prime Minister had the right to accept, reject, or add to the list. The Prime Minister then advised the President who made the award, with the consent of the nominee.

The Legacy of a Librarian

The design of the Trinity Cross

TRINITY CROSS

THE TRINITY CROSS, which is 1969 was unveiled as the country's highest national award, was the result of a national competition to select a design for the prestigious award. The winner of the competition was librarian Wilhelmina Mc Dowell.

In the 1940's Mc Dowell became a student of prominent Trinidadian artist, M.P Alladin. He encouraged her early talent and laid the foundation for the sketch which would become her most celebrated piece.

Towards the end of the 1960's, as Trinidad and Tobago stood on the brink of independence, Mc Dowell, a Woodbrook, resident, entered and won a nationwide competition to design the Trinity Cross.

Her careful meticulous drawing in black Indian ink captured the beauty of the twin-islands. Through the use of two rare birds unique to Trinidad and Tobago mounted on a simple cross, the Cocorico and the Scarlet Ibis evoked a sense of pride and nationalism at a pivotal time in the country's coming of age.

At its centre Ms. Mc Dowell depicted the Trinity Hills, reputed to be the first land sighting of Trinidad and Tobago by Christopher Columbus. For Mc Dowell, the insignia of the cross used in the design represented merit and distinction, a symbol worn by knights of the highest order in recognition of their bravery.

To date there are sixty eight holders of the original Trinity Cross for their contribution to Law, Justice, Trade Unionism, Medicine, Science, Education, the Arts and Culture, Sport, National and Regional Development and more. In 2008 the award was redesigned and renamed the Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.

The Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago

The Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago was installed as Trinidad and Tobago's new highest national award in 2008 and replaces the Trinity Cross for Distinguished and Outstanding Service to Trinidad and Tobago.

The design of the Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago acknowledges the contribution of the first inhabitants of Trinidad and Tobago as embodied in the crest surmounting the medallion. The waves and constellation tell the story that Trinidad and Tobago consists of people from all over the world and their descendants, combining particular social and cultural attributes to produce a special, talented people with a great potential to live in harmony and prosperity.

The award is 18 carat yellow gold and hangs from a short length striped gros-grain ribbon in the national colours, red, white and black. On the front of the award, there are three circles each encompassing a feature of the National Symbols of Trinidad and Tobago, with a crest at the top. Within the crest is a feathered headdress of an Amerindian chief which represents the Amerindian culture of the twin-islands.

The centre of the design features a disc upon which one of our national birds, the Scarlet Ibis is standing on the south western peninsula of Trinidad with the Mot Mot perched on the image of Tobago, both imposed in bas-leaf. At the top and side of the circle is the Chaconia, the National Flower of Trinidad and Tobago.

In the middle circle there is a display of the twelve outer notes of a tenor pan. These twelve notes represent the many social and cultural contributions that the citizens of Trinidad and Tobago have made to their country. Upon these notes is a pair of pan sticks. The steel pan is represented on the award as it is the National instrument of the twin-island republic. Within the third and outer circles are images which represent the sea and sky. The waves at the bottom represent the sea whilst the sky is represented via clusters of star shapes and fine granulation.

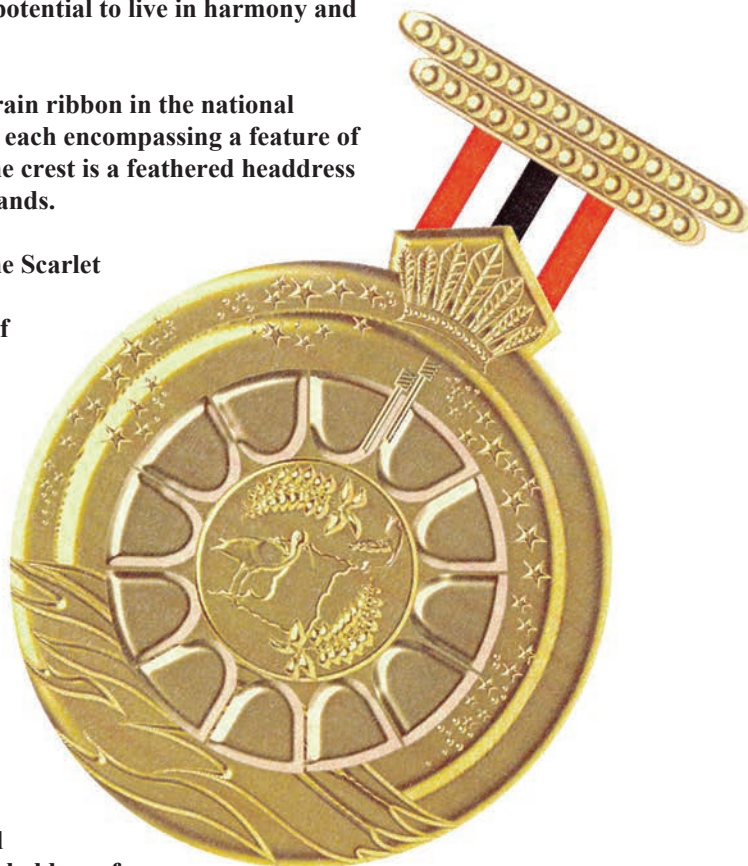
On the back of the award, the words "Order of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago" are engraved.

The name of the Society to replace the Order of the Trinity is The Distinguished Society of Trinidad and Tobago and the initials O.R.T.T. is to be used by future holders of the award after their names.
