INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - JANUARY, 2001

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of January, 2001 was 139.9 showing a decrease of 0.4% below the Index for December, 2000.

The All Items Index for January, 2001 showed an increase of 4.8% over that for January, 2000. This compares with an increase of 3.7% observed in the Index for January, 2000 over that for January, 1999.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section decreased from 237.6 in December, 2000 to 234.7 in January, 2001, a decline of 1.2%. Within the Food Section there was a decrease of 3.9% in the index for market items. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of tomatoes, irish potatoes, sweet and hot peppers, melongene and carrots.

Price changes in this section accounted for an overall decrease of 0.6 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

Santiana

A further review of the data for January, 2001 indicated that increases were recorded for the following: Meals Out, 0.6%; Health and Personal Care, 0.7%. Decreases were recorded for Drink and Tobacco, 0.1%; Clothing and Footwear, 0.2%; Household Supplies and Services, 0.1%; and Reading, Recreation, Education, 0.2%.

Price changes in these sections accounted for an overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in January, 2001 compared with those of January, 2000 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
