AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF RACING 2000

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY wishes to advise of the following amendments to the Rules of Racing, 2000:

Rule 38(7)

In line one, after the word "meeting", include "or exercise any horse".

Rule 43(3):

After the words "chin strap" include as well as a "body protector".

Rule 49(14):

In line one, after the words "Protectors", include "as well as Skull caps fitted with a chin strap".

Rule 71:

In line three, delete the words "or one who fails to come under Starter's Orders for the race".

The above Amendments to the Rules of Racing were approved at a meeting of the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority held on Thursday 8th November, 2001.
