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APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY INTO THE PIARCO AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

EXTENSION OF DEADLINE DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF MEMORANDA

IN ACCORDANCE with section 15 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, Chap. 19:01 of the Laws of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, it is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the President, A. N. R. ROBINSON, T.C., O.C.C., S.C., in exercise of the powers vested in him under section 2 of the said Act, has issued a Commission, appointing the persons named hereunder as Commissioners to enquire into the Piarco Airport Development Project:

The Terms of Reference of the Commission are—

(a) To enquire into the Piarco Airport Development Project and into:

The entire process involved in the selection of consultants, the procurement of contractors and suppliers, the commissioning, design, construction, maintenance and operations, the establishment of ancillary and supporting infrastructure and the financing for the establishment of the new airport terminal building at Piarco inclusive of the Piarco Development Plan;

The circumstances surrounding the procurement process and the award of all contracts from the inception of the project to the date of completion thereof;

The criteria used for packaging and awarding all contracts and whether or not it was in the best interest of the client, that is, the Ministry of Works and Transport;

The role, responsibilities and terms of reference of Birk Hillman Consultants and the circumstances concerning any conflicts of interest arising among interested parties and the awardees of contracts;

The basis for cost and time overruns, acceleration incentives, change orders and/or claim settlements and matters incidental thereto;

(b) To make such observations and recommendations arising out of its deliberations as the Commission may deem appropriate.
