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DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION TO DEPENDANTS OF DECEASED EMPLOYEE

COMPENSATION in the above matter having been deposited with me under section 9 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, the dependants of the said Timkin Mahabir are hereby required to appear before the Commissioner on MONDAY THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH, 2003, at 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon at the Court House, Port-of-Spain, when the Commissioner shall proceed to determine the distribution thereof.

Proof of relationship of dependants to the deceased workman will be required by the Commissioner to be furnished by claimants at the enquiry. Such proof to be in the form of certificates of birth and of marriage as in the circumstances be necessary.

A claimant for funeral expenses of the deceased must submit and prove his claim to the Commissioner before the 10th day of March, 2003.

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TENDERS FOR PROVISION OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF A SUPPLY/SUBSTITUTE TEACHER SYSTEM FOR THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE SECONDARY EDUCATION MODERNIZATION PROGRAMME (SEMP) IDB LOAN 1180/OC-TT

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Education (MOE) has accessed loan funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for a Secondary Education Modernization Programme (SEMP) IDB Loan 1180/OC-TT, the goal of which is to modernize the secondary education sector in Trinidad and Tobago. One of the major components of the Programme is the Institutional Strengthening which is geared towards embracing management and operational efficiency of the Ministry of Education. Several training projects have been planned with respect to the implementation of this component, inclusive of training in manpower planning for the selected staff and development of a system of supply teachers for the human resource department of the Ministry of Education.

In this regard, proposals are invited from interested individuals to design, develop and deliver a supply/substitute teacher system that will form part of the human resource management capabilities at the Ministry level and at the school level.
