## APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE

*(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Ralph M. Newton, Acting Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the private warehouse of Messrs. Toyota Trinidad and Tobago Limited of 130, Seventh Street, Barataria—Road Motor Vehicles and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

### SCHEDULE

A fenced uncovered area measuring 13.70 metres on its northern side; 14.08 metres on its southern side, 26.15 metres on its eastern side and 26.50 metres on its western side. The fence itself is constructed of chain link wire supported by steel posts on the northern, southern and eastern sides and of BRC wire in metal framework on the western side to an all round height of approximately 1.8 metres.

The Warehouse is bounded on the north by Sixth Street, on the south by Seventh Street, on the east by No. 128 Seventh Street and on the west by Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and is situated at 130, Seventh Street, Barataria.
