RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTATION OF BIRDS AND BIRD PRODUCTS FROM CALIFORNIA AND NEVADA
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

PLEASE be advised that there is currently an outbreak of Exotic Newcastle disease in California and Nevada, United States of America. The Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Marine Resources is therefore not granting any permits under the Animal Diseases and Importation Act (Chap. 67:02, 1980 Rev.) for the importation into or transit through Trinidad and Tobago of the following birds and bird products originating from California and Nevada, United States of America:

- (a) All domestic and wild birds including day old birds;
- (b) Hatching eggs, semen and fresh meat of domestic and wild birds;
- (c) Meat products of domestic and wild birds that have not been processed to ensure the destruction of the Newcastle Disease virus, including poultry meat and edible meat products, unpasteurized edible eggs and egg products such as table eggs/shell eggs, whole eggs, egg shells, yolk, albumen or any combination of these products in liquid, fresh, frozen or dried form;
- (d) Products of animal origin (from birds) intended for use in animal feeding or for agricultural or industrial use, including—
 - (i) unprocessed feathers or down that have not been washed, are not clean, free of dirty blood, faeces or ectoparasites and inedible poultry meat and meat products;
 - (ii) inedible eggs and egg products;
 - (iii) fertilizers or compost containing poultry products/by-products or poultry manure;
 - (iv) rendered poultry products such as or containing poultry meal, feather meal, poultry liver meal, poultry digest, poultry blood meal, spray dried poultry blood;
 - (v) rendered or non edible poultry fattened oils livestock feed;
 - (vi) pet food containing any poultry products/by-products carcass/parts of game animals; and
 - (vii) laboratory material containing poultry products/by-products (subject to the discretion of the Chief Technical Officer).

These precautions are based on the O.I.E. Animal Health Code for 2002, Newcastle Disease (Chap. 2.1.15, Article 2.1.15.4) and are effective from 10th January, 2003.

Permits may still be granted for birds and bird products originating from elsewhere in the United States of America.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Marine Resources will continue to monitor the situation and will amend the restriction as required.
