## INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—April, 2005

(Base: January, 2003 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of April, 2005 was 111.6 representing an increase of 0.4 points or 0.4% over the Index for March, 2005.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January—April, 2005 over that for the period January—April, 2004 was 6.8%. This compares with an increase of 3.0% observed in the average All Items Index for January—April, 2004 over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2003.

### SECTION INDICES

#### FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 144.9 in March, 2005 to 145.0 in April, 2005, an increase of 0.1%. Contributing to this increase was a general rise in the prices of paw paw, chive, sweet potatoes, dasheen, whole chicken, pumpkin, and limes. Partly offsetting these increases were decreases in the prices of cucumbers, tomatoes, celery, hot peppers, ochroes, sweet peppers, fish (king, carite), bodie and melongene.

Price changes in this section, for the month of April, 2005, accounted for a net overall increase of .02 points in the All Items Index.

#### OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for April, 2005 compared with March, 2005 indicated increases in Clothing and Footwear, 0.1%; Rent, 1.2%; Health, 1.8%; Transportation, 0.5%; Recreation and Culture, 1.0%; Education, 3.7%; Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants, 0.1% and Miscellaneous, 1.4%.

Price changes in these sections, for the month of April, 2005, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.38 point in the All Items Index.
