The Disciplinary Tribunal of the Council of the Medical Board of Trinidad and Tobago, met on 26th September and 17th October, 2005, respectively, to hear relevant testimonials on Dr. Raj-kumar's behalf, as ordered by Justice Ian Benjamin that Dr. Godfrey Raj-kumar be heard in mitigation prior to the passing of sentence.

However, the Tribunal ultimately agreed that the weight of circumstantial evidence brought before the Tribunal, pointed to the fact that Dr. Raj-kumar, without the consent or knowledge of the doctor who issued the report on the histology of the tissue specimen submitted for expert interpretation, altered the substantive content of that report. In so doing, Dr. Raj-kumar actively committed a dishonest act without apparent regard to its implications for either (a) the doctor who wrote the report, or (b) any other doctor who might be subsequently involved in the case and who may wish to inform themselves of its details.

Therefore, after due deliberations the Tribunal unanimously agreed that the sanction of erasure is to be imposed on Dr. Godfrey Raj-kumar. This order of erasure from the Register of Medical Practitioners will take effect from the date on which Dr. Raj-kumar receives notification of Council's decision.

NOTICE TO QUARRY OPERATORS ON STATE AND PRIVATE LANDS

INVITATION TO APPLY FOR QUARRY LICENCES

The Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries invite quarry operators currently operating on STATE and PRIVATE LANDS, whose operations were ongoing continuously during the period January 1 to December 31, 2005 to apply for a Licence for the regularization of their operations subject to the conditions listed hereunder:

CONDITIONS

1. The Licence shall be valid for a term of one (1) year and shall automatically expire at the end of the said term;
2. Any implication that an expectation is created by the grant of this one (1) year Licence to a further term is hereby expressly excluded;
3. At the end of the one (1) year term, the Licensee may be granted a Licence over the Licensed Area, for a period not exceeding five (5) years, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions, three months prior to the expiration of the Licence,
 - i. Submission of an approved survey plan of the Licenced Area to the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries;
 - ii. Payment of all outstanding royalties where applicable;
 - iii. Proof that the applicant possesses ownership of the mineral rights to the area to be licensed;
 - iv. Submission of a mine design plan, a restoration plan, Environmental Impact Assessment and a Certificate of Environmental Clearance approved by the Environmental Management Authority;
 - v. All the relevant regulatory approvals;
 - vi. Rehabilitation of all exhausted pits;
 - vii. Establishment of a closed loop circulation system in quarries with wash plant facilities; and
 - viii. Installation of adequate housing for crushers and conveyor systems in quarries with dry crushing plant facilities.

4. Such other conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct.

APPLICATION DOCUMENT

The application forms for quarry licences can be collected from the Minerals Division of the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries, located at Moonan Building, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable application fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) should accompany each application. Payment of the said application fee should be made in favour of the Permanent Secretary and should be paid at the Accounts Department, Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries, Level 8 Riverside Plaza, Besson Street, Port of Spain.
