- (ii) the Company is deemed to be unable to pay its debts under Section 77 of the Act.



THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Public Administration and Information (MPAI) has accessed loan funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for a Public Sector Reform Initiation Programme (PSRIP) (IDB Loan No. 1523/OC-TT). The general objective of the Programme is to support the initial development and implementation of a long-term strategy to reform the Public Sector in order to meet the national goal of achieving developed country status by the year 2020.

The implementation of this Programme will involve the commissioning of a number of technical studies in the area of governance and institutional assessment. In addition, the Programme will support a number of initiatives geared towards strengthening the public sector's reform management capacity. These include developing a compensation policy suitable to attract, motivate and retain adequate personnel for the Public Service in line with the strategic goals of Public Sector Reform.
