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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—May, 2007

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of May, 2007, was 130.1 representing an increase of 0.8 point or 0.6% over the Index for April, 2007.

The annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January–May, 2007, over that for the period January–May, 2006, was 8.3%. This compares with an increase of 6.9% observed in the average All Items Index for January–May, 2006, over the average All Items Index for the same period in 2005.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 205.8 in April, 2007 to 210.0 in May, 2007, reflecting an increase of 2.0%. Contributing significantly to this increase was a general rise in the prices of limes, sweet potatoes, christophene, oranges, mangoes, lettuce, watercress, sweet pepper, chive, celery, green bananas, onion, tomatoes, hot peppers, plantain, bodie, cucumber, carrots and powdered milk. Partly offsetting these increases were general price decreases in dasheen, yam, whole chicken, Irish potatoes, pawpaw and soft drinks.

Price changes in this section, for the month of May, 2007, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.8 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for May, 2007, compared with April, 2007, indicated an increase in the general price level for Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels 0.4% and Health 0.1%. However, general price decreases were noted for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco 0.7% and Clothing and Footwear 0.9%.

Price changes in these sections, for the month of May, 2007, had a negligible net overall effect on the All Items Index.
