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TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE NATIONAL SMART CARD SYSTEM OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FOR THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

TENDERS are invited for the supply, delivery, implementation, operation and maintenance of the National Smart Card System of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for the Ministry of Social Development.

A pre-tender meeting will be held on Wednesday 23rd May, 2007, at 10.00 a.m. at the Probation Office, Ansa Building, 3rd Floor, (Conference Room), Corner Queen and Henry Streets, Port-of-Spain.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender;
- (b) valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Tenders, original and six (6) copies each should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside—

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or a representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the slot in the Tenders Box are 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm. and as such, tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting its tender.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.
