Dated the 29th day of July, 2011

Upon Reading the Claimant's Fixed Date Claim and Affidavit in support thereof together with the exhibits annexed thereto.*And upon Hearing* Attorney-at-law for the Claimant and Attorney-at-law for the 2nd Defendant, the 1st Defendant not appearing and not being represented.*It is Hereby Ordered that—*

The Claimant having paid the sum of twenty-three thousand, two hundred and fifty dollars (\$23,250.00) comprising the sum of seventeen thousand, six hundred dollars (\$17,600.00) in fines to satisfy the orders of the Disciplinary Committee and the sum of five thousand, six hundred and fifty dollars (\$5,650.00) comprising the sum of five thousand, three hundred and fifty dollars (\$5,350.00) to the Law Association of Trinidad and Tobago through the Supreme Court of Judicature as outstanding fees of annual subscriptions for the issuing of practicing certificates for the years 2000–2001, 2009–2010 and 2010–2011 and the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to the Registrar of the Supreme Court of Judicature as outstanding fees for the period 2000–2001, 2009–2010 and 2010–2011 law terms—

- (1) The Court declares that the suspension of the Claimant which was occasioned on the 27th April, 2011 by insertion of an annotation into the Roll of Attorneys-at-law and further published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette* of the 28th April, 2011, be and the same is hereby lifted and that all consequent procedures be undertaken to give effect to such lifting;
- (2) The Court orders that the Registrar of the Supreme Court of Judicature do issue to the Claimant a practicing certificate for the law terms 2000–2001, 2009–2010 and 2010–2011 and have the name of the Claimant restored to the Roll of Attorneys-at-law to practice law in this jurisdiction and have the suspension of the Claimant lifted and order the Registrar to re-enter the name of the Attorney-at-law on the Roll, and to have such notice of lifting of the suspension and re-entering of the Roll published in the *Gazette* forthwith, being an Attorney-at-law who has, for twelve (12) months or more, not held a valid practicing certificate who has been suspended from practice and had her name struck off the Roll, and who having paid her dues asks for her name to be restored to the Roll and who has paid all sums of monies ordered by the Disciplinary Committee;
- (3) The length of notice of six (6) weeks to the Registrar of the Supreme Court of Judicature of this application provided for in section 24(1) of the Legal Profession Act, 1986, be and is hereby abridged to today's date.
