MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 17) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 17) Order, 2011.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Akbar Fuad Ali	Solicitor, admitted to practise in the Senior Courts of England and Wales in July, 1976.

PART II

Mr. Akbar Fuad Ali, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:

Civil Appeal No. 281 of 2008 (National Insurance Property Development Company Limited v NH International Caribbean Limited);

Civil Appeal No. 246 of 2009 (NH International Caribbean Limited v National Insurance Property Development Company Limited); and

Civil Appeal No. 251 of 2009 (National Insurance Property Development Company Limited v NH International Caribbean Limited).
