MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF
JUSTICE UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 7) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 7) Order, 2011.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in Ontario, Canada for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago, subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

PART II

Ms. Cynthia Amsterdam is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause, namely:

Commission of Enquiry into the failure of CL Financial Limited, Colonial Life Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, CLICO Investment Bank Limited, British American Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, Caribbean Money Market Brokers Limited and the Hindu Credit Union Cooperative Society Limited, acting on behalf of PricewaterhouseCoopers Trinidad and Tobago, a listed party.
