NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE WHICH REQUIRES AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUBMITTED BY REPSOL E&P T&T LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that Repsol E&P T&T Limited (“Repsol”) is desirous of drilling four (4) development wells for oil and natural gas as part of the Teak Infill Drilling Campaign, within the Teak, Samaan and Poui (“TSP”) Block, located offshore the south-east coast, Trinidad. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order (as amended), thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 (“the Act”). Repsol has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) from the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) for this project.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application for the Certificate for the drilling of four (4) development wells for oil and natural gas as part of the Teak Infill Drilling Campaign, within the TSP Block, located offshore the south-east coast, Trinidad, which requires an Environmental Impact Assessment.

And take notice that the Authority has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in

developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, No. 8 Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain.

The Authority will receive public comments on the application from Monday 12th August, 2013 to Friday 20th September, 2013.
