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## INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—October, 2013 (Base: January, 2003 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of October, 2013 was 210.5 representing an increase of 2.5 points or 1.2% above the All Items Index for September, 2013.

The percentage change in the All Items Index for the period January to October, 2013 over the period January to October, 2012 was 5.2%. This reflects a decrease when compared with the rate of inflation of 9.6% observed in the All Items Index for the period January to October, 2012 over the period January to October, 2011.

### SECTION INDICES

#### FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 515.0 in September, 2013 to 528.9 in October, 2013 reflecting an increase of 2.7%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of yams, cucumber, tomatoes, celery, melongene, christophene, avocado, whole chickens, oranges and carite. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of dasheen, limes, hot peppers, ochroes, pumpkin, canned vegetables, green pigeon peas, plantains, chive/thyme and water cress.

Price changes in this section, for the month of October, 2013 accounted for a net overall increase of 2.5 points in the All Items Index.

#### OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for October, 2013 compared with September, 2013 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.3%, Clothing and Footwear of 0.3%, Housing, Water, Electricity and Gas 0.2%, Health 0.2%, Education 2.3%, Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants 1.7%, Miscellaneous Goods and Services 1.7%. However, decreases were noted in the sub-indices for Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of the House of 0.2%, Transport 0.1% and Recreation and Culture 2.4%.

Price changes in the Other Sections, for the month of October, 2013 was negligible.

Changes in consumer prices in October, 2013 compared with those of October, 2012 reflected in various sections of the Index are shown hereunder—
