MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 15(A) OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 4) ORDER, 2014

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for <sup>Citation</sup> Admission) (No. 4) Order, 2014.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a <sup>Eligibility for</sup> Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales <sup>admission to</sup> for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law <sup>practise</sup> in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Simon Christopher Peter Knox, QC,	Of the Honourable Society of Middle Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in November, 1986 and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 2006.

PART II

Mr. Simon Christopher Peter Knox, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of, or in connection with the cause, namely:

An Investigation pursuant to the Securities Act, 2012 by the Trinidad and Tobago Securities and Exchange Commission into suspected violations of the Securities Act, 2012 with respect to the purchase and trading of First Citizens Bank Limited Shares ("FIRST") by Hassan Phillip Rahaman.
