A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS section 238(1) of the Defence Act, Chap. 14:01 provides, *inter alia*, that the President may call out the Volunteer Defence Force or any portion of it for actual military service with their arms and ammunition, in aid of the civil power in any case in which a riot, disturbance of the peace, or other emergency requiring such service occurs, or is, in the opinion of the President, anticipated as likely to occur, and in either case to be beyond the powers of the civil authorities to suppress, or to prevent, or deal with:

And whereas the President deems it necessary to call out to duty one officer and sixty-four other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force to serve as a reserve corps to assist the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force for parades during the months of August and September, 2014 as well as to assist the civil authority in providing security support for law enforcement activities throughout Trinidad and Tobago leading into and including the Christmas period:

Now, therefore, I, ANTHONY THOMAS AQUINAS CARMONA, President as aforesaid, do hereby call out to duty one officer and sixty-four other ranks of the Trinidad and Tobago Volunteer Defence Force for the period 29th August, 2014 to 7th January, 2015, to serve as a reserve corps to assist the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force for parades during the months of August and September, 2014 as well as to assist the civil authority in providing security support for law enforcement activities throughout Trinidad and Tobago leading into and including the Christmas period.
