ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER
SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (MARAVAL/ST. JAMES) ORDER, 2014

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Maraval/^{Citation} St. James) Order, 2014.

2. A person driving a motor vehicle may proceed in an easterly and ^{Two-way} westerly direction on Rapsey Street, between Wainwright Street and ^{traffic} Saddle Road between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday except on a public holiday.

3. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding east on Rapsey ^{No left turn} Street shall not turn left onto Saddle Road between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday except on a public holiday.

4. Between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday ^{One-way} except on a public holiday, a person driving a motor vehicle shall ^{traffic} proceed in—

- (a) a south-easterly direction only on Saddle Road, from Long Circular Road to Rapsey Street;
- (b) an easterly direction only on Patna Street, between Agra Street and Long Circular Road;
- (c) a northerly direction only on Bengal Street, between Patna Street and Delhi Street;
- (d) a southerly direction only on Long Circular Road, between Patna Street and Delhi Street; and
- (e) a westerly direction only on Delhi Street, between Long Circular Road and Calcutta Street.

5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order ^{Offence and} commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of ^{penalty} three thousand dollars or to imprisonment for three months.
