MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)  
(PORT-OF-SPAIN/ST. JAMES) REGULATIONS, 2016

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation  
(Experimental Scheme) (Port-of-Spain/St. James) Regulations, 2016.
2. These Regulations come into operation on Monday 8th August, Duration  
2016 and expire on Monday 7th November, 2016.

PART I  
PORT-OF-SPAIN

3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on—  
(a) the road commonly referred to as the Zoo Road between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.; and  
(b) the road between Lady Chancellor Road and the road commonly referred to as the Zoo Road between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

PART II  
ST. JAMES

4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the eastern side of Vidale Street.
5. A person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on summary conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by a member of the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
