ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER
SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (INDEPENDENCE SQUARE NORTH
AND ELIZABETH STREET, PORT-OF-SPAIN) ORDER, 2016

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Independence ^{Citation} Square North and Elizabeth Street, Port-of-Spain) Order, 2016.
2. This Order shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday ^{Commencement} 22nd August, 2016.
3. (1) A person driving a motor vehicle, other than an official ^{No parking} motor vehicle of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, shall not park on the northern side of Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street, from a point nine metres west of St. Vincent Street and extending to a point forty-nine metres further westwards as marked, Monday to Friday.

(2) A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the eastern side of Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Sweet Briar Road, from a point nine metres south of St. Clair Avenue and extending to a point forty-nine metres further southwards, as marked.
4. A person who contravenes the provisions of this Order is liable ^{Offence and} on summary conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine of seven ^{penalty} hundred and fifty dollars and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the ^{Removal and} commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in ^{impounding} contravention of this Order may be removed by a member of the Police ^{of vehicles} Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with ^{unlawfully} section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. ^{parked}
