ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 65
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (PRIORITY BUS ROUTE,
ST. AUGUSTINE) ORDER, 2016

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Priority Bus Citation Route, St. Augustine) Order, 2016.
2. This Order takes effect from Monday 5th September, 2016. Commencement
3. A person driving a motor vehicle— No “U”-turn
 - (a) proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall not make a “U”-turn in, or in the vicinity of, the National Petroleum Gas Station, St. Augustine, to proceed west; and
 - (b) proceeding west along the Priority Bus Route shall not make a “U”-turn in, or in the vicinity of, the National Petroleum Gas Station, St. Augustine, to proceed east.
4. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding west along the No entry Priority Bus Route shall not enter the exit lane of the National Petroleum Gas Station, St. Augustine.
5. A person who contravenes this Order is liable on summary Offence and conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars penalty and on subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.
6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding contravention of this Order may be removed by a member of the of vehicles Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with unlawfully section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. parked
