THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF  
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (COUVA)  
REGULATIONS, 2016

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation  
(Experimental Scheme) (Couva) Regulations, 2016.

2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 25th April, 2016 Duration  
and expire on Sunday 24th July, 2016.

3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the eastern Parking  
side of Church Street, from Balisier Street to Church Street Extension, prohibited  
except for a Magistrate and persons driving official prisoner transport  
motor vehicles and prisoner motor vehicles.

4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in— One-way traffic

(a) a northerly direction only on Hosein Street, between the  
hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.,  
Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;

(b) a westerly direction only on Manse Street, between  
Williams Street and the entrance to Balmain Presbyterian  
Primary School, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m.  
and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on  
public holidays;

(c) in a northerly direction only on Williams Street, between  
Manse Street and Balmain Main Road, between the hours  
of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday  
to Friday, except on public holidays;

- (d) a southerly direction only on Church Street, between Balisier Street and Church Street Extension, Monday to Friday, between the the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
- (e) a northerly direction only on Victoria Street, between Carli Bay River Road and Balisier Street;
- (f) a westerly direction only on Grant Street, between Bryce Street and De Gannes Street;
- (g) an easterly direction only on La Croix Street, between Bryce Street and De Gannes Street; and
- (h) in a northerly direction only on De Gannes Street, between Grant Street and La Croix Street.

5. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not enter Bryce Street, <sup>No entry</sup> between La Croix Street and Grant Street, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

6. Any person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on <sup>Offence and</sup> summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and <sup>penalty</sup> fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the <sup>Removal and</sup> commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in <sup>impounding</sup> contravention of these Regulations may be removed by a member of the <sup>of vehicles</sup> Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with <sup>unlawfully</sup> section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. <sup>parked</sup>
