



5. By decision of the Board on July 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 the Commission took a decision to delegate two (2) additional powers to the Chief Executive Officer, namely:
  - (i) The power to remove Sponsored Broker-Dealers and Sponsored Investment Advisers from the Commission's register when their registrations under section 51(5) of the Act expire.
