REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)  
(PRINCES TOWN MAXI-TAXI) REGULATIONS, 2017

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control<sup>Citation</sup>  
(Experimental Scheme) (Princes Town Maxi-Taxi) Regulations, 2017.
2. These Regulations shall come into operation on Monday<sup>Duration</sup>  
5th June, 2017 and expire on Monday 4th September, 2017.
3. A maxi-taxi driver plying Route Area (4)—<sup>Maxi-taxi  
stand</sup>
  - (a) along the Princes Town to Rio Claro, Moruga and  
St. Mary's routes, shall park facing south on the eastern  
side of Buen Intento Road, from Waterlane Street and  
extending northwards, as marked; and
  - (b) along the Princes Town to Tableland, New Grant and Sixth  
Company routes, shall park facing north on the western  
side of Charlotte Street, from Naparima-Mayaro Road and  
extending southward, as marked.
4. A person driving a motor vehicle along Theodore Street shall not<sup>No right turn</sup>  
turn right on reaching its intersection with Buen Intento Road.
5. A person driving a maxi-taxi along Charlotte Street shall not<sup>No left turn</sup>  
turn left on reaching its intersection with Naparima-Mayaro Road.
6. A person driving a maxi-taxi shall not enter the Princes Town<sup>No entry</sup>  
Car Park.
7. A person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on<sup>Offence and  
penalty</sup>  
summary conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine of seven  
hundred and fifty dollars and in the case of a second or subsequent  
offence, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles  
unlawfully  
parked

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by a member of the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
